Titan Club Scheduled to Host Special Needs Basketball Camp

The Titan Club and Detroit Titan Athletics are gearing up to host the Third Annual Titan Club Basketball Camp for Special Needs Players on Friday, June 28.

Campers will have the opportunity to learn and develop skills in a fun environment, Calihan Hall, located on the campus of the University of Detroit Mercy. Open to children 12 years of age and older, the camp is designed for trainable mental impairment (TMI), educable mental impairment (EMI) and other developmental or physical disabilities.

Participants will receive both individual and group instructions as well as hearing from members of the Detroit Titans Division I men's and women's basketball programs. Parents and guardians are encouraged to stay to watch and cheer.

The cost of the camp is \$15, which includes a t-shirt, a Certificate of Completion and a gift. Registration forms are located on the Detroit Titan webpage with a June 26 deadline. The camp is scheduled to run on June 28 from 9:00-12:00.
