WHIM 5-PIECE COMFORTER SET

Web ID: 1747994 (Mirror Mirror), 1747993 (Pretty in Poppy), 1747992 (Spot Chevron), 1747995 (Two-Tone Stripe)

The 5-Piece Comforter Set comes in four different patterns that can be combined with any of the quilts and sheet sets included in the Whim collection. Each element — even the decorative pillows — is machine washable and comes in Twin/Twin XL, Full/Queen, and King sizes. Set includes: Comforter, 2 shams (1 sham in Twin/Twin XL), 2 decorative pillows (16 x 16" and 12 x 18")

MAKE MAGIC TIP: Pick out solid and printed sheet sets that you think look best with each bed,

and recommend the customer stock up so she has a full rotation of sheets — one on the bed, one in the laundry, and one in reserve.

WHIM QUILTS AND SHAMS

Web ID: 1748094 (Different Strokes), 1748095 (Pretty in Poppy), 1748096 (Vine Time) The Quilts and Shams have 100% cotton shells and come in three patterns that coordinate back to the Whim top of beds and sheet sets. Quilts are available in Twin/Twin XL, Full/Queen, and King sizes, and the shams (sold separately) are available in Standard and King sizes.

MAKE MAGIC TIP: Layering quilts is a popular way to manage sleep temperatures. They can be doubled on cooler nights and turned down when nights are warm. Show the customer which quilts you think look best together.

WHIM SHEET SETS

The 100% Cotton Percale Sheet Sets are machine washable and come in four solid colors and five patterns. They're available in Twin, Twin XL, Full, Queen, King, and Cal King sizes. The Twin XL size is perfect for the customer shopping for a college dorm bed. *Set includes: Flat Sheet, Fitted Sheet, Pillowcase(s)*

MAKE MAGIC TIP: Remind the customer that percale sheets are best as a summer sheet, or an all-year sheet for someone who gets warm at night, as they're known for feeling crisp and cool.



ENAMELED CAST IRON COOKWARE

Be sure to look for the new colors debuting this quarter in the Enameled Cast Iron 6-quart pot. Enameled cast iron is so versatile. Martha uses it for everything from baking casseroles to browning meats. Its heavy construction distributes heat efficiently and traps moisture to enrich braises, stews, and pot roasts. THREE-CHEESE LASAGNA

Serves 4 to 6

- 2 cans (one 28 ounces and one 15 ounces) whole peeled plum tomatoes
- 3 garlic cloves, finely chopped
- 3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil
- Coarse salt and freshly ground pepper
- 1 large egg yolk
- 1½ cups part-skim ricotta cheese (12 ounces), room temperature
- 1 box (12 ounces) no-boil lasagna noodles
- 2 cups shredded fresh mozzarella cheese (½ pound)
- ¼ cup grated Pecorino Romano or Parmigiano-Reggiano cheese (1 ounce)

Directions

Active time 30 minutes Total time 1 hour

Preheat oven to 400°F. In a food processor, pulse tomatoes (with their liquid) until coarsely puréed. In a large sauté pan, bring tomatoes, garlic, and oil to a boil over medium-high heat. Season with salt and pepper. Reduce to medium and simmer until thickened, about 12 minutes (you should have about 5 cups marinara sauce).



Meanwhile, in a bowl, mix together egg yolk, ricotta, and ½ teaspoon each of salt and pepper.

Carefully pour sauce into a heatproof bowl, and return ¾ cup to pan; spread sauce evenly. Add a single layer of noodles, breaking them up to fit. Top with half the ricotta mixture, spreading evenly. Follow with a second layer of noodles, then 1½ cups marinara. Add a third layer of noodles, then remaining ricotta mixture. Follow with a final noodle layer, then remaining sauce. Sprinkle mozzarella and Pecorino over top.

Bake lasagna until golden and bubbling, 30 to 35 minutes. Let stand 10 minutes before serving.

BAKED RISOTTO WITH CARROTS AND SQUASH Serves 4

• 2 tablespoons vegetable oil

- 2 tablespoons vegetable off
 1 small onion, finely diced
- 4 garlic cloves, minced
- 2 tablespoons minced peeled fresh ginger
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- Coarse salt
- 3 medium carrots, cut on a diagonal into ³/₄-inch slices (2 cups)
- 1 cup Arborio rice
- ½ cup red lentils, picked over and rinsed
- 2½ cups water
- ½ small butternut squash, peeled, seeded, and cut into 1-inch chunks
- Lime wedges and fresh cilantro sprigs, for serving

Directions

Active Time 30 minutes Total Time 1 hour

Preheat oven to 400°F. In a 6-quart enameled cast iron casserole, heat oil over medium-high. Add onion, garlic, ginger, cumin, and 1½ teaspoons salt; cook until onion is translucent, about 3 minutes. Add carrots, rice, and lentils; cook, stirring, 1 minute. Add the water, and bring to a boil. Add squash and return to a boil. Cover and transfer to oven. Cook until liquid is absorbed and rice is tender, about 20 minutes. Let sit, covered, 10 minutes before serving. Squeeze with lime wedge, and top with cilantro.
