

Historic Houses of Worship

Since 1972, the Historic Houses of Worship tours have acquainted metro Detroiters with the contributions religious institutions have made in the development of our community.

Our Historic Houses of Worship tours normally run from 10 a.m.-4 p.m., the first Monday of the month from March through June and September through December. Our regular tours include visits to up to five locations, motor coach transportation and lunch, starting at \$40 per person.

We have several options for groups interested in our tours:

- If you have 15 people or less, you can join us on our bus for one of our regularly scheduled Historic Houses of Worship tours.
- If you have more than 15 people, you can book your own bus to follow our bus and join our tour.
- If you would like to book a different date and have at least 25 people, we have Historic Houses of Worship tours available by appointment.

Belle Isle by Bus Tour

Another bus tour that we offer is Belle Isle by Bus, which starts at the Dossin Great Lakes Museum on Belle Isle. A docent will join your group on the bus to lead you around the island. Our tour typically lasts 90 minutes to 2 hours and includes a few stops, such as Scott Fountain and a monument or two. The cost is \$25 per person. Groups are encouraged to visit the Conservatory or Nature Zoo at their leisure following the tour.
