

October through April, the resort offers 90-minute I.FLY Trapeze classes for guests 4 and up, where you'll learn timing and techniques for swinging, locking your legs on a bar and completing the famous wrist-to-wrist catch. Meanwhile, iScavenger hunts provide fun

on the ground with a journey of puzzles, games and exploration of the resort.

It's impossible not to have a good time at The Westin Kierland, where there's a staff member whose job is to make sure that you do! The resort's "Director of Fun" runs a kid-friendly check-in at Kierland Mining Co., where tykes receive a specialized scavenger hunt.
